accelerate  		  short (<1 sec.) 1 km/h long (1> sec.) stepless  orange
decelerate  		  short (<1 sec.) 1 km/h long (1> sec.) stepless  orange
resume  		 orange
de-activate (cancel)  		 green
switch Off  		 off
memory's*  		program: press & hold for 2 sec. usage: press 1x

Cruise Control

- The Cruise Control can be used from 40 km/h
- Don't use the Cruise Control during bad weather
- The Cruise Control does not slow down! But only release the throttle
- It's always possible to accelerate in the interim by pressing the throttle. After that the car will resume the set speed if the speed has not been increased by more than 50% compared to the set speed

The Cruise Control will switch off with:

- Braking
- Pressing the clutch (if connected)
- De-activate
- Switch off Cruise Control
- Decrease speed by 25% compared to the set speed
- Increase speed by 50% compared to the set speed
- Switch off the ignition
